REPLY MEMORANDUM RE: VERIFICATION OF FILING

Bankruptcy files are public records and information concerning them may be researched by any individual or agency. It appears that at some time you filed papers with the Court and that information is being obtained by the credit agencies for distribution to their clients. Should you believe the information being provided by these agencies is inaccurate, it will be necessary for you to provide them with proof that the case was in fact dismissed before conclusion or does not pertain to you.

If you were represented by legal counsel during the pendency of your case, your attorney may be able to provide you with the needed papers. In addition, copies of all relevant court papers were mailed to you during the pendency of your case.

You may investigate your record in person if the file is still available in our office. If the file has been shipped to the Federal Record Center in Riverside, California, it may be recalled for you to review in our office. There is a charge for this service.

Copies of documents may be obtained through the mail or in person. There is a charge for this service.

The Court will research its records to determine information as requested in writing. There is a charge for this service. There is no charge if you complete your own research in person.
