

GetPDF – Initial Installation and Setup

Unzip the file GetPDF.Zip into a temporary folder. Then run Setup.Exe.
(If you are running Windows NT, 2000 or XP you will need Administrator privileges.)
By default the program will be installed in C:\GetPDF, but you can change it if needed.

When the installation has completed, go to C:\GetPDF (or whatever folder you chose)
and make three desktop shortcuts: GetPDF.Exe, MovePDF.Exe and ArcPDF.Exe.

File Locations

The first time you run GetPDF you will be presented with the **File Locations** setup screen. Once you have set this up you should never have to deal with this again.

- Path to Database

Set this to the folder where the program was installed (C:\GetPDF is the default). This is where the contents of Data.Zip will be extracted.

- Path to Images

This will be where all of your PDFs will reside. (You will need to create this using My Computer or Windows Explorer.) For our example we will use C:\Cases, but you could use anything you want.

- Locate Acrobat Reader

Here you will locate either the Acrobat Reader (AcroRd32.Exe) or the Acrobat program itself (Acrobat.Exe). It is usually under C:\Program Files\Adobe\... - you may have to hunt for it.
