The Court adopts the October 17, 2006 "United States Trustee Chapter 13 Attorney Fee Guidelines" and the "Rights and Responsibilities of Chapter 13 Debtors and Their Attorneys" as its own on an interim basis, and will publish same on the court's website and will treat them as local court forms until further order of the Court.
