

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15 The Trustee submitted a first and final application for fees

16 in this case. Applying the provisions of 11 U.S.C. § 326, the

17 Trustee requested \$19,728.75 on expected distributions of

18 \$329,575.06.

19 By separate orders, the Court fixed the amount of fees and

20 costs allowed to the Trustee's attorneys, and invited the Trustee

21 and United States Trustee to discuss whether the Trustee may seek

22 fees for distributions to his or her own professionals, as well

23 as the distribution to the trustee, himself or herself. In

24 response, the Trustee in this case withdrew his request for fees

25 for disbursements both to his professionals and himself, thus

26 reducing disbursements under § 326 to \$276,280.89, and further

1 subtracting the portion allocable to the Trustee for his own fees
2 at 5%, producing a net request of fees in the amount of
3 \$16,210.83. Because of the Trustee's withdrawal of his request
4 for fees on those disbursements, the United States Trustee
5 concluded the matter was moot.

6 For the reasons set forth in part in this Court's Order
7 entered February 2, 2007, and because of the Trustee's reduced
8 request, fees shall be, and hereby are allowed to the Trustee
9 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 326, in the amount of \$16,210.83. No
10 separate amount of costs or expenses was sought in the
11 application.

12 IT IS SO ORDERED.
