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22 Bankruptcy Receivables Management (Plaintiff) moved  
23 this Court for an order appointing counsel for defendant  
24 Autumn F. Crowther aka Autumn F. Porter (Defendant) pursuant  
25 to 50 U.S.C. § 521(b)(2). Plaintiff correctly pointed out  
26 that under 50 U.S.C. § 521(b)(2), since Defendant was a

1 servicemember (50 U.S.C. § 511(1)) in the military service,  
2 the Court could not "enter a judgment until after the court  
3 appoints an attorney to represent the defendant..."  
4 However, Plaintiff provided the Court neither authority nor  
5 procedure by which the Court could make such an appointment,  
6 let alone pay for it. The Court took the matter under  
7 submission and instructed Plaintiff to file supplemental  
8 authorities by July 31, 2008.

9 As of August 22, 2008, Plaintiff has provided no such  
10 authorities. Accordingly, the Court hereby denies  
11 Plaintiff's motion without prejudice.
