




1 trustee has not sought the same information of behalf of the  
2 estate. Given the current state of this Chapter 7 case, the  
3 Court finds and concludes that Lennar's motions are essentially  
4 efforts to assist them in their efforts to collect a state court  
5 judgment, which is collateral to the bankruptcy process.  
6 Moreover, the Court has recently learned Lennar has been seeking  
7 the same sort of information in the state court. Macaluso v.  
8 Superior Court, \_\_\_\_ Cal. App. 4<sup>th</sup> \_\_\_\_, (2013 DJDAR 12695  
9 (Fourth Dist. 2013)). The Court declines to participate in  
10 Lennar's discovery efforts.

11 Accordingly, Lennar's motions are denied, without prejudice.
