

16 The Court has previously authorized interim compensation to
17 Premier Golf Property Management, at an amount less than
18 requested. Since taking under submission the balance of
19 management's request, the Court has reviewed the interim
20 operating reports, and is concerned about the level of funds
21 generated by operation of this estate, as well as the high rate
22 of administrative expenses being generated. Given that Premier
23 Golf Property Management, as well as its principal, are insiders
24 of this debtor, the Court has determined that at the present time
25 award of additional fees is not in the best interests of this
26 estate. Accordingly, the remaining portion of the request is

1 denied at the present time, without prejudice to a future
2 application as the feasibility of funding it becomes more clear.
