
Pursuant to Title 28, United States Code, Section 753,

IT IS ORDERED that, effective October 1, 2023, the following transcript rates per page are prescribed by the Court.

| 30-Day Transcript (Ordinary) A transcript to be delivered within thirty (30) calendar days after receipt of an order. | \$4.00 | \$1.00 | \$0.70 |
| 14-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within fourteen (14) calendar days after receipt of an order. | \$4.70 | \$1.00 | \$0.70 |
| 7-Day Transcript (Expedited) A transcript to be delivered within seven (7) calendar days after receipt of an order. | \$5.35 | \$1.00 | \$0.70 |
| 3-Day Transcript A transcript to be delivered within three (3) calendar days after receipt of an order. | \$6.00 | \$1.20 | \$0.85 |
| Next-Day Transcript (Daily) A transcript to be delivered on the calendar day following receipt of the order (regardless of whether that calendar day is a weekend or holiday), prior to the normal opening hour of the clerk's office. | \$6.70 | \$1.35 | \$1.00 |
