

VACATING ORDER EXTENDING CERTAIN DEADLINES DURING THE COVID-19 PUBLIC EMERGENCY

On March 25, 2020, this court entered its Administrative Order 20-3 after consultation with the United States Trustee extending certain deadlines until further order of the court due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. Administrative Order 20-3 has remained in effect since that time.

On June 11, 2021, the District Court for the Southern District of California entered its Chief Judge Order No. 59-A allowing the resumption of in person hearings due to the abatement of many of the circumstances of the public emergency caused by COVID-19 as people have become vaccinated.

After further consultation with the United States Trustee, the court has determined that extension of these deadlines is no longer necessary.

Accordingly, Administrative Order 20-3 is vacated effective August 2, 2021 and deadlines will be restored on that date to the dates otherwise imposed by the Bankruptcy Code, Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, or Local Bankruptcy Rules of this court.
